# "Scroll Your Roll"

#### **OVERVIEW**

This simple activity will spark conversations about who people are outside of work or the classroom. It is a great way to have people share parts of their world in a low risk way!

Time needed: 5 minutes

Where to use it: Staff meetings, department meetings, or in the classroom

Set-up: Have people pair up with someone they don't work with everyday. Have the partners determine

who will be #1 and #2.

#### **ACTIVITY**

Start by having person #2 go to their photos on their phone and swipe their screen up 3X. Pick one photo from where the phone stopped and simply share with their partner what is happening in that photo. Give them 60 seconds to share what was happening. Then have the #1 person go next. If you have time, have the partner ask one follow-up question about something they heard.

#### **ACTIVITY REMIX: SCAVENGER HUNT**

Once you have tried Scoll Your Roll a few times, try the scavenger hunt remix. At the start of a meeting, have people pull out their phones and the first person to show a picture of one of the themes you choose (sample list below) would win something fun. Have people turn to someone near them and share the photo they found.

### **SCAVENGER HUNT TOPIC IDEAS**

- A delicious meal
- A trip you've been on
- A person who means a lot to you
- A pet you love
- A beautiful landscape/nature photo
- A picture of you doing something you care about (a hobby)
- A sunset
- · Something you have had to fix
- Something random
- The last screenshot you took
- Something that made you laugh
