The directions are simple: Have each student and staff member write down something or someone they are thankful for.

CULTURE RESULTS:

HELPFUL TIPS:

- Prepare in advance! Get the paper and start making the die cuts early for both students and staff
- Teachers and/or Activities Director should review what is written for appropriateness
- Find a high traffic location to post the collage
- Vary the design from year to year. Ideas: cornucopia, pumpkin, traditional fall food items, heart, tree with fall leaves
- Ideas to spell out: THANKS, THANKFUL, GRATEFUL, TOGETHER
